Chairman Rusty Newton called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Administrative Items:

- 2. Solomon presented the Solid Waste Director's Report
 - a. Solomon noted that the Recycling Grant in the amount of \$496,425 and a Mulching Grant in the amount of \$24,750 was awarded since last meeting.
 - b. Newton mentioned that the 109 Taxing District Web Site needs to be up to date with recent minutes. Magan will forward minutes to Solomon.
- 3. Long presented the Clean Community Report.

Old Business:

- 1. Wood Environmental has made their site visit to the Waddy and Shelbyville Landfills. They will attend the next regular meeting.
- 2. Ariel Sarno informed Magan of the "slip", which Solomon photographed prior to the May meeting. Magan will inquire about producing a project request for bids to remediate the issue prior to the next regular meeting.

New Business: Solomon informed the Board that an environmental contractor is interested in hauling material to either of the landfills. This action fits in with the board's desire to have material on site for the next repair.
