Presentation of Credit Card Refunds for Departments – Sheila McGee, County Treasurer

On motion by Judge Ison second by Esq. Eades and carried it is ordered to issue incentive payment of \$4,083.96 to Magistrate, Karen Waller, for completion of 40 hours of training for calendar year 2026.

Sandra Ashcraft, Jailer presented the Detention Center budget for FY 2026-2027.

On motion by Esq. Waller second by Esq. Eades and carried it is ordered to accept a check in the amount of \$528,836.34 for Final Settlement and Excess Fees for 2025 from County Clerk Tony Harover.
