On motion by Esq. Swindler second by Esq. Eades and carried it is ordered to accept the bid from Comfort Systems USA in the amount of \$74,146.00, with quarterly payments over the term of agreement. Comfort Systems USA has already been doing the majority of the repairs inside the Judicial Center for HVAC. The 4% automatic annual increase proposed by Perfection Group also is a reason for Comfort Systems.

On motion by Esq. Eades second by Esq. Witt and carried it is ordered for Judge Executive to execute a Planned Service Agreement between Shelby County Fiscal Court and Johnson Controls for fire safety inspections for the Shelby County Judicial Center for \$1,800.00 annually.

On motion by Esq. Waller second by Esq. Witt and carried it is ordered to approve Judge Executive to execute HB 556 Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) 2026 through 2028 between the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Justice and Public Safety Cabinet, Department of Corrections, and Shelbyville Detention Center.

On motion by Esq. Hedges second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve the solicitation of bids for the Substance Abuse Program (SAP) provider at the Detention Center. Current contract ends 6/30/26.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve the solicitation of bids for the Commissary provider at the Detention Center. Current contract ends 6/30/26.

On motion by Esq. Witt second by Esq. Hedges and carried it is ordered to approve Judge Executive to execute a non-opposition letter to the Louisville Riverport Authority's Application, establishing a sub-zone within a foreign trade zone for KUEHNE NAGEL INC.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Waller and carried it is ordered to hire Steve Rusch, as Level I Building Inspector, with a pay rate of \$65,000.00 annually, effective 4/9/2026, contingent on updated job description.

On motion by Esq. Swindler second by Esq. Lisby and carried it is ordered to hire Jose Sanchez as full-time Deputy Jailer, with a pay rate of \$19.00/hr. effective 4/20/2026.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Waller and carried it is ordered that Shelby County Fiscal Court will retain U of L Health Occupational Medicine as our Occupational Health needs partner and will not be switching to Baptist Health. (Both parties have been notified).

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve revised job description, Animal Control Manager, increase in salary range to \$55,000.00 - \$85,000.00/year, add Animal Control Supervisor as position supervised, add responsibility of reviewing timecards for accuracy and submitting to finance, and removal of verbiage relating to wildlife, effective 7/1/26.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve revised job description, Animal Control Supervisor, increase in hourly range to \$22.00-\$30.00/hour, removal of verbiage relating to wildlife, removal of vocational training as an education requirement, add training in animal control or animal behavior, add KACCA certification to be obtained within six months of employment, add requirement of the ability to lift up to 100 lbs. on a regular basis, effective 7/1/26.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve revised job description, Animal Control Officer, increase in hourly range to \$18.00-\$25.00/hr., removal of Euthanasia certification, add KACCA certification to be obtained within six months of employment, add condition of employment to be eligible for certification as state peace officer, updated availability to include this position may require 24 hour on call assignment, overtime, or working weekends, effective 7/1/26.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve revised job description, Part Time Litter Abatement Technician, increase hourly range to \$18.00-\$21.00/hr., add verbiage to include training will be provided to obtain Class D Workers Certification, add condition of employment – Fiscal Court Approval, change the ability to lift 25 lbs. to 100 lbs. on a regular basis.

On motion by Esq. Lisby second by Esq. Swindler and carried it is ordered to approve revised job description, Equipment Operator III, remove 2 certifications that are no longer offered, and one that is for interstate work zones. Also, add the ability to lift and carry 100 pounds.

On motion by Esq. Swindler second by Esq. Lisby and carried it is ordered to hire Winston Harris as part-time EMT with a pay rate of \$20.00/hr. effective 4/10/26.
