ORDINANCE NO. 07-02-04, SERIES 2019

AN ORDINANCE REVISING AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 06-20-08,
SERIES 2006, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 08-07-06, SERIES 2007,
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE FOR SHELBY COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, KRS 68.005, as amended, requires counties to adopt a county administrative code providing for procedures and designating responsibilities for the administration of county government business and affairs, and

WHEREAS, Shelby County, Kentucky, through the Shelby County Fiscal Court, has previously adopted an administrative code providing for procedures and designating responsibilities for the administration of county government business and affairs by Ordinance No. 06-20-08, series 2006, as amended by Ordinance No. 08-07-06, Series 2007, and

WHEREAS, Shelby County, Kentucky, through the Shelby County Fiscal Court, has reviewed that code and, based upon that review, now wishes to revise and amend said code to provide for efficient and efficient delivery of government services to the people of Shelby County, Kentucky,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Shelby County, Kentucky, through the Shelby Fiscal Court, pursuant to the authority granted by KRS 68.005, that Ordinance No. 06-20-08, Series 2006, as amended by Ordinance No. 08-07-06, Series 2007, Administrative Code for Shelby County, Kentucky is revised and amended as follows:

8. PAYROLL POLICIES

Salary Increases

Pending budgetary constraints, and except as otherwise provided herein, pay/salary increases may or may not be given. Increases may be given based on: 1. cost of living; 2. promotion; and/or 3. Industry/position adjustment.

County elected officials not covered by the KRS 64.5275 shall automatically receive the KRS 64.527 annual Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment in February of each year. Fiscal court may decline the CPI increase for those elected county officials referenced herein, in any year, by order, resolution or an approved motion. The order, resolution or approved motion shall only apply to that year's CPI.
